

**FLYERS FANS RACE IN COSTUME DURING FLYERS CHARITIES HALLOWEEN
5K AT XFINITY LIVE! PHILADELPHIA ON OCTOBER 25**

Philadelphia, PA August 11, 2014 – Competitive and amateur runners can race in costume or their favorite Flyers gear during the annual Flyers Charities Halloween 5k at XFINITY Live! Philadelphia on Saturday, October 25 beginning at 9 a.m.

The top male and female runners in each four age group categories will be awarded a pair of tickets to a mutually agreed upon game during the Flyers 2014-15 season. Prizes for best costumes will also be awarded. Competing alongside Flyers fans will be legendary goaltender Bernie Parent who will be running in preparation of a half-marathon he is planning to run in the Fall.

Runners with a valid Running Bib will have the rare opportunity to watch to the Flyers players take part in their "morning skate" at the Wells Fargo Center immediately following the run at 10:30 a.m. The Flyers take on the Detroit Red Wings that evening at the Wells Fargo Center beginning at 7 p.m. Morning Skate is subject to change.

The event also features a family fun area with Flyers inflatables, face painters and pumpkin painting.
