

**PRESIDENT OBAMA AND GOVERNOR ROMNEY TO FACE-OFF ON 32-FT HD SCREEN AT
XFINITY LIVE! PHILADELPHIA ON OCTOBER 16**

Philadelphia, PA – October 15, 2012 – Presidential candidates President Barack Obama and Governor Mitt Romney will face-off on a 32-foot Sony High Definition screen at XFINITY Live! Philadelphia on Tuesday, October 16 beginning at 9 p.m.
