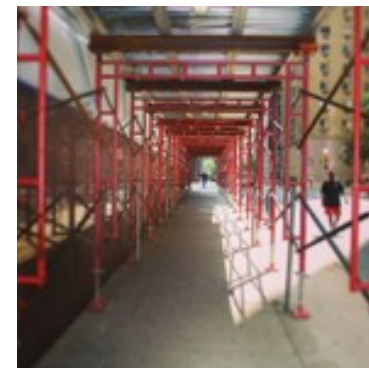

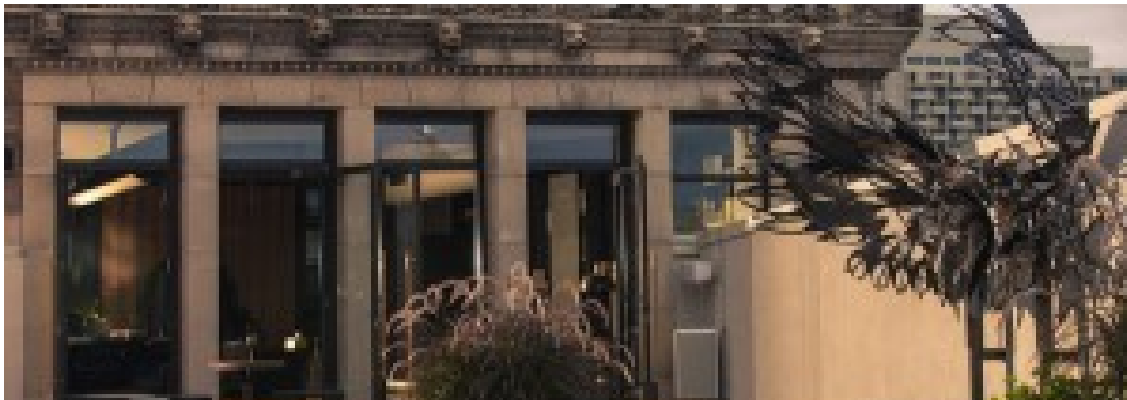
Sampan's Graffiti Bar

Cavanaugh's River Deck

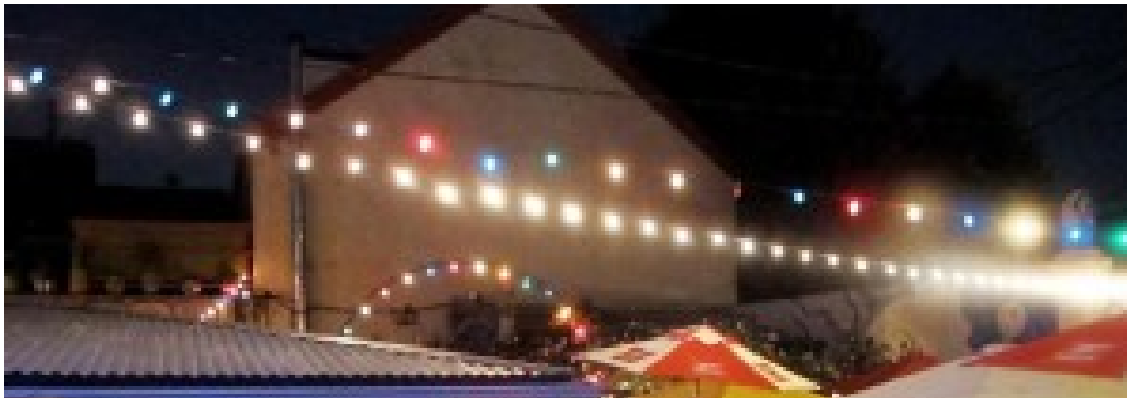
One of the best parties can be found at Cavanaugh's River Deck.

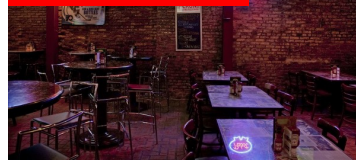
